Role	Description
Biomedical Engineer Intern	Assists chief biomedical engineer and staff engineers with project management and daily administrative tasks. Volunteers also shadow engineers and attend project and staff meetings with engineers.
Biomedical Engineer	They have a specific program that hires graduate biomedical/clinical engineers for two-year paid training programs. The program provides one-on-one training and mentoring as well as opportunities to attend national conferences and network with other trainees in the program.
Biomedical Engineer	Biomedical Engineers function as the health care technology experts in a medical setting. These professionals are responsible for patient safety through the planning, implementation and sustainment of health care technology.
Biomedical Engineer	Chief Biomedical Engineers encompass all of the duties of a staff-level engineer as well as managing the Biomedical Engineering program at the hospital. They supervise staff-level engineers, Biomedical Equipment Support Specialists (BESS), Networking BESS, Electronics Technicians, and administrative support.
